Outward Bound California ("OBCA") is a nonprofit adventure-based educational organization with programs that deliver character development and self-discovery in the wilderness, cities, and schools with a core mission of changing lives through challenge and discovery. Outward Bound California, based in San Francisco, strives to bring the life-changing experiences of the Outward Bound educational model to students from around the state.

OBCA seeks an **Executive Director** ("ED") who is a **visionary leader** to spearhead its growth and scale of its educational programs for youth and adults, promoting resiliency, self-awareness, and team building. This is an exciting opportunity to join a **well-established**, **35-year-old organization** with a track record of being a leader in experiential education and leadership development. There is a **18-member board of directors**, **110 staff members at peak season**, and an annual operating budget of **\$4.4 million**. Approximately 50% of annual revenue is generated through philanthropic sources and the remaining 50% is generated through fee-based program offerings. There is a **\$15 million comprehensive campaign** underway. OBCA is an exciting **social enterprise within a nonprofit organizational structure**.

The ED will provide executive leadership and management, offer strategies for expanding OBCA's education program and operations statewide, support the organization's fundraising efforts for both the capital campaign and the annual fund, steward the Outward Bound education model and its impact, be the spokesperson for OBCA, and serve as the executive liaison with the OBCA Board and with Outward Bound USA.

The ideal candidate will bring the following experience:

- A proven track record of successful education or nonprofit management with a minimum of ten years experience including time in an executive or senior management role, ideally with P&L responsibility.
- Demonstrated passion for and belief in OBCA's mission and the ability to communicate these to a wide array of audiences.
- Track record of or aptitude for **fundraising** from individuals and institutional funders.
- Building and managing an organization with increasing complexity of operations while maintaining program quality.
- Experience working successfully with a **wide array of external partners and stakeholders**.
- Demonstrated ability to effectively lead and manage in a team-oriented, casual and collegial office environment with a priority of Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion for organizational management.
- Experience working with or reporting to a board of directors.

An undergraduate degree is required; a graduate degree is a strong plus.
